The regularly scheduled monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the Vista Fire Protection District was called to order by presiding President, Read Miller, at 6:00 P.M. at Vista Fire Station #6, 651 East Vista Way, Vista, CA 92084.

- C. <u>Authorized Signatures for District Accounts</u>. The Board received a report from the Treasurer, Jeff Golden, as well as Director Elliott regarding the signature authority for the VPFD accounts. The recommended action is: Adoption of Resolution No. <u>2020-1</u>, designating officers with authority to invest, transfer, and expend funds, establishing signature authority for banking purposes, and establishing fund controls. This resolution rescinds all previous authorizations for Officers of VFPD related to the investment, transfer, and/or expenditure of funds. Per the recommendation of legal counsel, Fred Pfister, language of resolution required amendment. On a motion made by Director Elliot, and duly seconded by Director Hill, amended Resolution <u>2020-1</u> has been adopted by the District. Revised Resolution will be brought to March meeting in order to be signed.
- D.<u>2018-2019 Annual Audit Report</u>. Received a draft of the 2018-19 Annual Audit from Douglas R. Ashbrook, CPA. Payment not yet approved due to final audit report not yet submitted. Moved to March Agenda.

- A. <u>Emergency Access Roads</u>. Director Hill reported Contractor De Boer is currently working on required road repairs and erosion control. Fire Chief Vander Pol provided photos of working in progress at Par Valley off Twin Oaks entrance.

- D. <u>Fire Marshalls Report</u>. Deputy Fire Chief Craig Usher reported they are currently integrating the new electronic program for weed abatement, and notices will go out to people in violation. No forced abatements were issued in 2019.
- E. <u>Fire Department Performance Report</u>. Fire Chief Ned Vander Pol reported on performance by the City of Vista's Fire Department during January 2020.
- F. <u>Fire Chief's Update</u>. Fire Chief Ned Vander Pol reported on other matters of interest to the Department and the District.
- G. <u>Application of New Employment Laws</u>. District Counsel reported on the application of employee classification laws on the District. Per discussion with Legal counsel, Board Clerk needs to be reclassified as an employee going forward. On a motion made by Director Elliott and duly seconded by Director Hill, Christie Ross will be reclassified as an employee instead of an Independent Contractor.
