- A. <u>District Fire Inspector's Report</u>. Fire Inspector, Jeremy Nichols described his activities in November, and his proposed activities for December.
- B. <u>Fire Marshalls Report</u>. Deputy Fire Chief Craig Usher discussed pending and approved projects for properties located within the District.

- B. <u>Portfolio Summary</u>. The Board reviewed the Treasurer's Report on the District Investments as of November 30, 2021.
- C. <u>Fire Mitigation Fees</u>. The Treasurer provided an update on the Mitigation fund balances held by the District and the City.
- D. <u>Legal Affairs</u>. District Counsel reported on the status of pending matters.

- A. <u>Fuel Modification</u>. The Subcommittee and staff reported on the status of the Anchor Point study.
- B. <u>Panoramic Property</u>. The Subcommittee on Panoramic reported on the status of the District's invitations of interest for purchase of the District's surplus property, including a proposed resolution authorizing an appraisal and offering the property for sale. On a motion made by Director Elliott and duly seconded by Director Gomez, the subcommittee is authorized to spend up to \$3,000 for site preparation, and to appoint Stephanie Cavanaugh of Realty Masters as the broker representing the District for the property's marketing and sale.
- C. <u>Response Times</u>. Director Gomez led a discussion concerning the possibility of an option to a site in the Bonsall Oaks development for a future substation.
- D. <u>Redevelopment Of Fire Station No. 3</u>. The Subcommittee reported on the status of joint funding for the redevelopment of Station No. 3.
